

Indoor Upholstered Furniture

A practical care reference for island conditions

Routine cleaning Vacuum gently with an upholstery attachment. Rotate loose cushions and blot spills promptly with a clean, absorbent cloth.	Approved cleaner types Use only products allowed by the fabric manufacturer's cleaning code (W, S, W/S or X). Test first in a hidden area.
Products to avoid Avoid bleach, harsh solvents, abrasive brushes, colored towels and saturating the fabric or foam.	Drying and ventilation Allow natural airflow and let the item dry completely before use. Do not apply direct high heat.
Mold or mildew precautions Keep furniture dry and away from persistent dampness. Address musty odors or spotting early; do not cover damp cushions.	Sun and moisture exposure Limit direct tropical sun and keep indoor fabrics away from rain, wet swimwear and open windows during storms.
When to contact Chung Nam Call for recurring stains, loose seams, sagging support, damaged foam, odors that remain after drying or uncertain cleaning codes.
