

Marine Vinyl & Boat Seating

A practical care reference for island conditions

Routine cleaning Rinse away salt and grit, then wash gently with a soft cloth and approved mild solution. Clean seams and piping without forcing water inside.	Approved cleaner types Use marine-vinyl cleaners listed by the vinyl manufacturer. Rinse away residue and follow any protectant instructions exactly.
Products to avoid Avoid household degreasers, gasoline, acetone, abrasive pads, magic erasers, waxes and unapproved silicone products.	Drying and ventilation Dry seating before covering the boat. Vent covers and compartments so heat and humidity do not remain trapped.
Mold or mildew precautions Clean organic residue early and inspect undersides, seams and storage areas. Never store cushions wet in a closed compartment.	Sun and moisture exposure UV, salt and standing water shorten material life. Use fitted breathable covers and shade when the boat is not in service.
When to contact Chung Nam Call for cracking, pink staining, open seams, waterlogged foam, loose fasteners or cushions that no longer drain properly.
