

Outdoor Cushions

A practical care reference for island conditions

Routine cleaning Brush off loose soil, rinse or clean as the fabric maker permits, and wipe spills before they set. Clean both sides of removable cushions.	Approved cleaner types Use mild soap or a cleaner specifically approved for the installed outdoor fabric. Follow the stated dilution and rinse directions.
Products to avoid Avoid pressure washing, stiff brushes, unapproved bleach, strong solvents and sealing damp cushions in storage.	Drying and ventilation Stand cushions on edge and open zippers when appropriate so covers and foam can drain and dry on all sides.
Mold or mildew precautions Mildew often grows on trapped dirt or moisture. Keep surfaces clean, maintain airflow and treat early with an approved product.	Sun and moisture exposure Performance fabric resists exposure but is not indestructible. Use shade and dry storage when practical to extend color and service life.
When to contact Chung Nam Call when water remains trapped, foam no longer recovers, seams open, covers shrink or stains require stronger treatment.
